Mile-a-Minute Quilting - April 11

Quilts are fun and fast to make when you create your own fabric out of scraps! Bring all your scrap fabric and learn this easy method to quickly sew them into blocks. Then use these blocks to create a tote bag in class. A great way to use up scraps!





Quarter Circle Quilts - May 30

Learn to sew a curved seam in constructing a traditional Drunkard's Path quilt block. Then use this simple block to design an eye-catching quilt. Your finished quilt will look stunning in jewel tone or Batik fabrics as well as more traditional patterns. Use your quilt as a wall hanging or table topper, or sew more blocks for a larger size quilt.

Quilt As You Go - August 1

Learn two quilt-as-you-go methods to make quilting a large quilt on your home sewing machine more manageable. The quilt-as-you-go method of quilting produces completely quilted blocks first and then attaches them together to form the entire quilt. Choose to straight-line or free-motion quilt. Your simple blocks will blossom as your quilt comes to life.





Disappearing Nine Patch - October 17

Easily construct a quilt pattern with a complex appearance by piecing together quilt blocks made from simple nine-patch blocks. Different arrangements plus varied fabric choices yield striking patterns. Great project for a beginner or anyone who wants to create a quick and attractive quilt.
